There can be three approaches to cleanliness:

Neutral Approach: No Deliberate action in his life. If one is clean it is by chance.

How to achieve the mission?

Three-pronged approach: Teachers-Students-Parents It is a team work. It requires persistent and sustained efforts. Teachers' Team: Primary, Middle and Senior Level Students' Teams: Awareness Program: slogans, placards, speech, skit, questionnaire, clean chart, etc. Incentives: Clean stars in the class rooms Mr. Clean Miss Clean Groundwork : Uniform check – Dress: neat and tidy Shoes: polished and brushed Nails: trimmed properly Hair: cut properly, oiled and combed Bag and one's materials maintained neatly Work : legible, neat, clean In the class, each row should be checking one another and report to the teacher. Monthly report to the Principal by the class teacher. Parents' involvement in sending the children as per instruction given in the school. Children are the reflection of their parents and their home. Surprise visit to the children's houses
